ELIGIBILITY & ACCEPTED MEDIUMS

Participation is open to all handmade fine arts and crafts. All work represented must be of an original concept executed and designed by the artist in attendance. No work which has been made with commercial kits, molds, patterns, plans or prefabricated pieces is allowed. No “buy/sell” or Retail Vendors allowed.

JURY INFORMATION

Jurying will be for the July 2022 Fair. **Jury fees will be waived for the 2022 Fair.**

Requirement for Jurying

- Send a CD or thumb drive with 5 digital images of your work and 1 image of your booth display, along with an “Artist Statement.” If emailed, images must be in JPG format of a high resolution to be juried effectively. Be sure to have at least one close up showing details.
- A one-page, brief but thorough, “Artist Statement” must accompany your application that will tell jurors about you and the work that you do. Include details such as how long you’ve been perfecting your work, what materials and techniques you use and any information pertinent to your art/craft.
- By submitting your photos, you authorize the MSACF to use them for any marketing/advertising for the Fair.

It is the artist’s responsibility to make sure we receive all application requirements on time. Juried applicants will be emailed or mailed notification as soon as possible.

Commission of 10% will be paid to MSACF on total sales at checkout on 7/3/22

WV State Sales Tax will be paid to the WV Tax Department on total sales at checkout on 7/3/22

The MSACF has the right, in the event of a National and/or State Emergency (including but not limited to COVID 19 mandates by government officials) to close/cancel/postpone the Fair
